



## POLL WORKER FACT SHEET

The Supervisor of Elections is currently accepting applications for poll workers to serve as clerks, inspectors, deputies, election assistants and voting equipment technicians for the 2010 midterm and gubernatorial elections. **All poll workers must be:**

- *A registered voter in Seminole County*
- *Able to read and write English*
- *Trained at one of the poll worker schools of instruction conducted prior to election day*
- *Able to arrive at the assigned polling place by 6:00 am on Election Day*
- *Available to remain at the polling place throughout the entire day of the election*
- *Public service oriented*

### MANDATORY SCHOOL OF INSTRUCTION

Poll workers are paid for attendance at a mandatory *School of Instruction* as well as for working during early voting or on election day. Training pay is included in the compensation levels outlined to the right. (Please note: you will only be paid for training if you actually work an election or remain available as an alternate for election day.)

**Temporary office positions are available preceding each election.** Interested applicants should have data entry, phone and organizational skills. Training assistants and warehouse help is also needed. Contact our office for more information.
